If you are experiencing severe pain/swelling, our hours are Mon. through Fri. 8:30 am – 12:00 pm. Patients are seen on a first come first seen basis. If seen as an emergency, patients may require a scheduled appointment to have their root canal completed at a later date.

- Patients will NOT be seen without a completed written OSU referral form from their general dentist and a valid government issued id.
- Payment for treatment is due at the time of service. We accept state-sponsored insurance plans.
